








Many jobs require a **résumé** as part of the application.




My résumé lists my **education**, for example the degrees I earned at university.









At the job **interview**, they will ask me many questions about my education, my experience, and why I want the job.




If they choose me, they make me a job offer.

The contract lists the **salary** for the job – how much they will pay me to do the job.



The contract also lists the employment **benefits**, for example health care, pension, holiday pay, and meal breaks.





I filled out an online application and the company called me for an interview!

I asked about the salary and the benefits.






She said the contract would include all of those details.
