

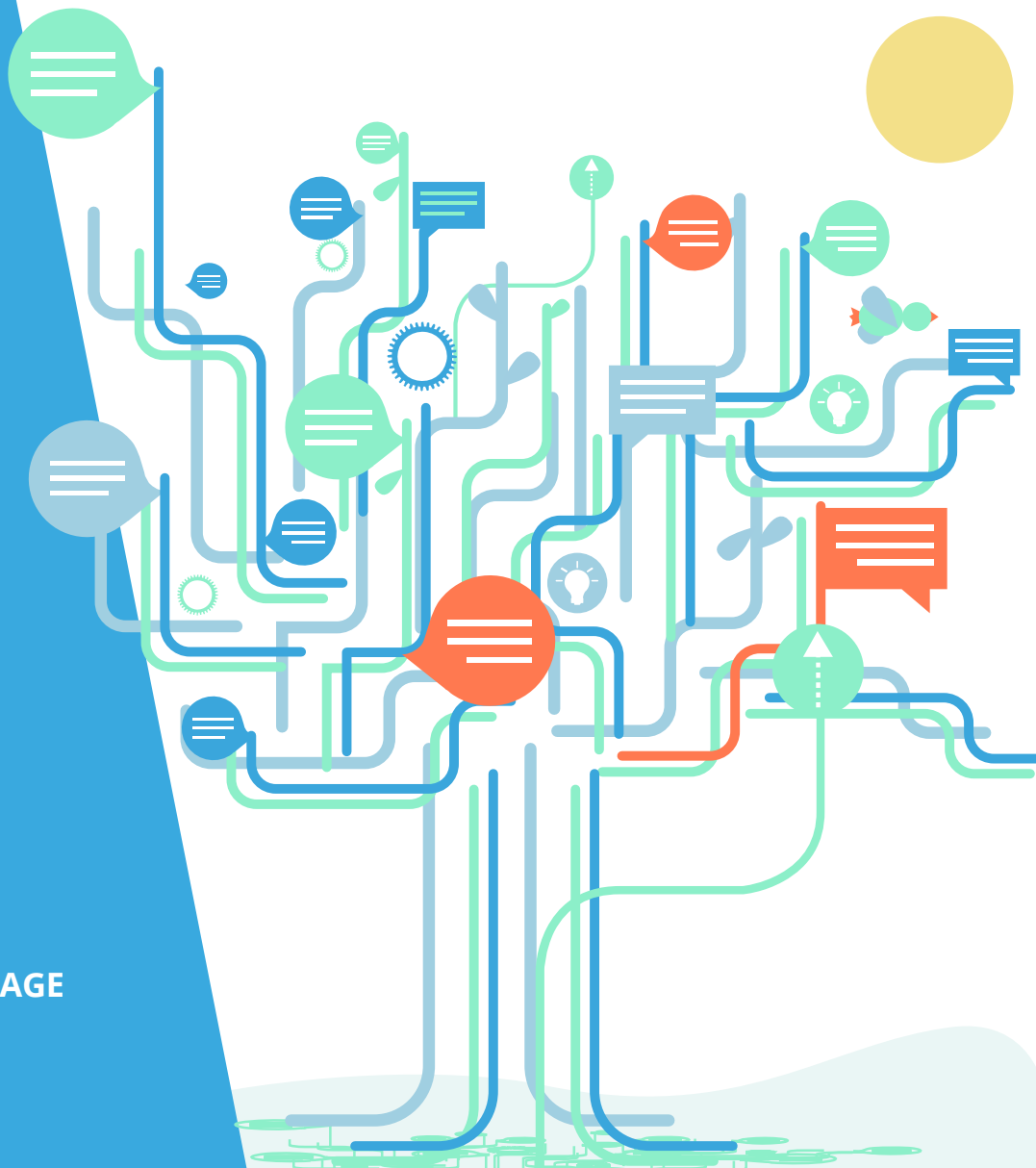

## Goals

- Learn how to form negative questions

**Which** days **don't** you work?  
I don't work on Saturday and Sunday.

doctor



A **doctor** helps sick people.

teacher



A **teacher** helps people learn.

hospital



A doctor works at a **hospital**.

school



A teacher works in a **school**.



Where are they?



Sick people go to the **hospital**.

People learn English at **school**.







Where do they work?



Who works in a **hospital**?

A **doctor** works in a **hospital**.



Who works in a **school**?

A **teacher** works in a **school**.





## Isn't and aren't

- We use **isn't** and **aren't** in **be** - questions.
  - **is not = isn't**
  - **are not = aren't**

Questions	Answers
Who <b>is</b> a doctor?	I am a doctor.
Who <b>isn't</b> a doctor?	You are not a doctor.
Who <b>is</b> a teacher?	You are a teacher.
Who <b>isn't</b> a teacher?	I am not a teacher.



## Don't and doesn't

- We use **don't** and **doesn't** in **do-** questions.
  - **do not = don't**
  - **does not = doesn't**

Questions	Answers
When <b>do</b> you drive to work?	I drive to work when traffic is light.
When <b>don't</b> you drive to work?	I <b>don't</b> drive to work when traffic is heavy.
Where <b>does</b> Kim live?	Kim lives in Switzerland.
Where <b>doesn't</b> Kim live?	Kim <b>doesn't</b> live in Germany.

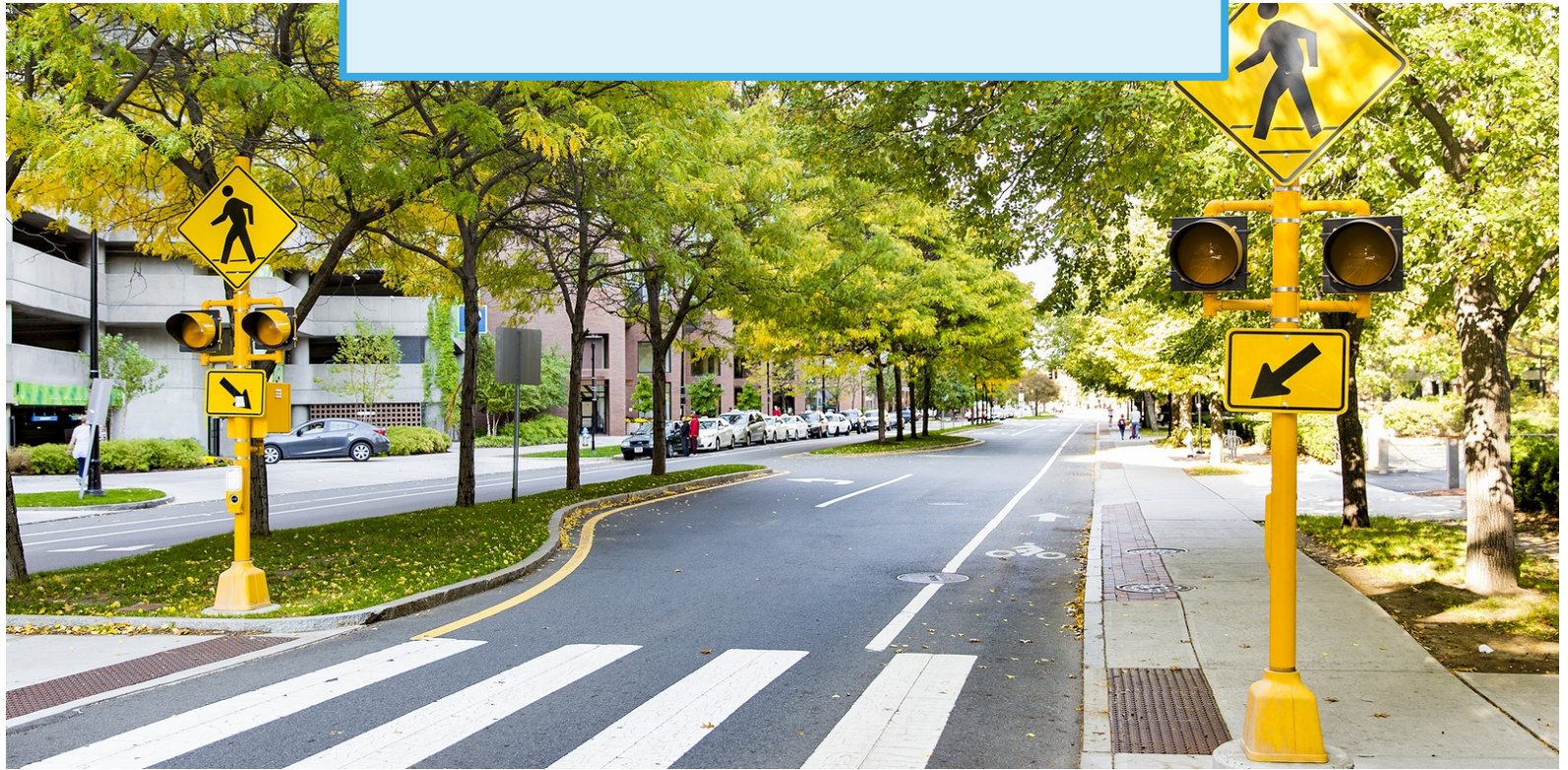

I ride my bike to work when **traffic is light.**

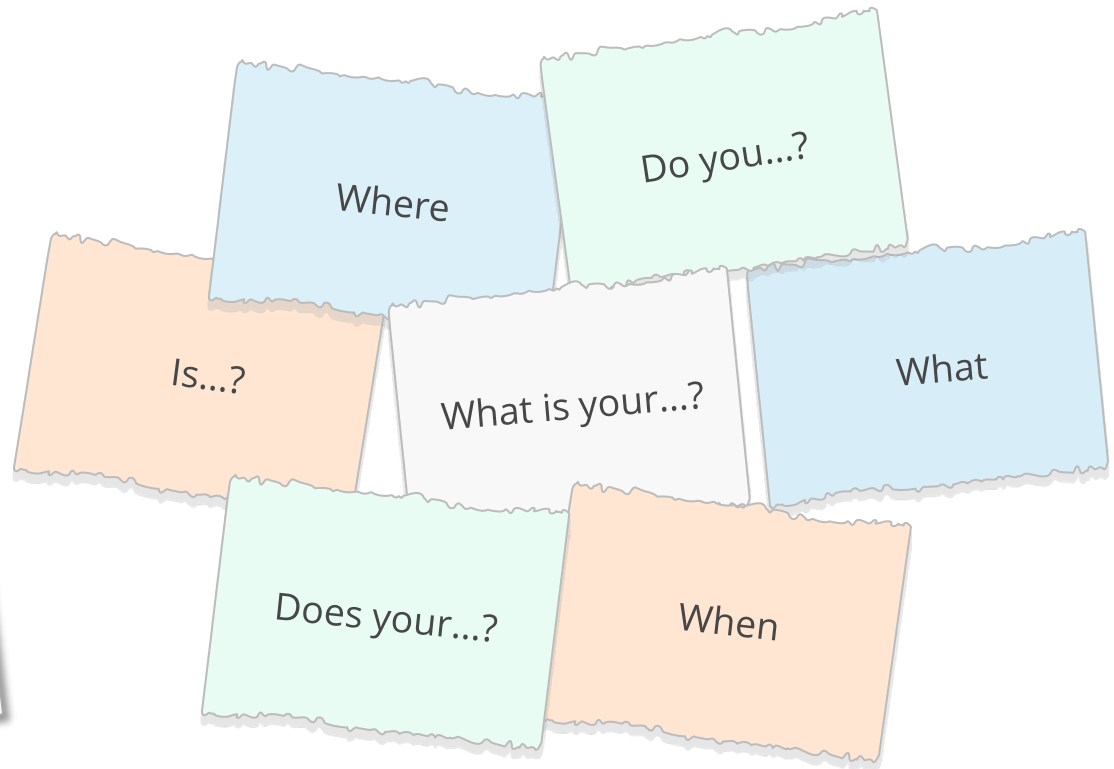
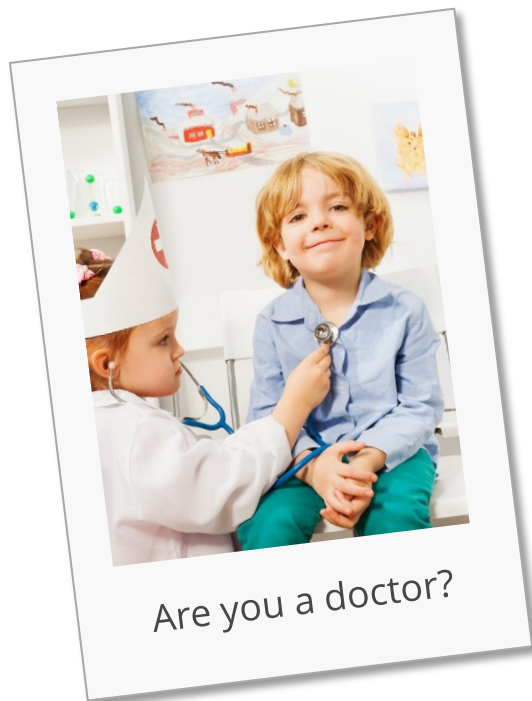

## Short questions

We can ask short questions.

	Questions	Short questions
I take the underground.	<b>When</b> do you take the underground?	<b>When?</b>
I am a doctor.	<b>Where</b> are you a doctor?	<b>Where?</b>
I don't drive a car.	<b>Why</b> don't you drive a car?	<b>Why?</b>
I don't work some days.	<b>Which days</b> don't you work?	<b>Which days?</b>



## Short answers

We can give short answers.

Questions	Answers	Short answers
<b>Who</b> is a doctor?	<b>I am</b> a doctor.	<b>I am.</b>
<b>Who</b> isn't a doctor?	<b>She isn't</b> a doctor.	<b>She isn't.</b>
<b>What</b> do you drive?	I drive <b>a car</b> .	<b>A car.</b>
<b>What</b> don't you drive?	I don't drive <b>a taxi</b> .	<b>A taxi.</b>

## Suggestions

- We can also make suggestions using the **negative form of do**:
- **Why + do/does + not + subject**

See the examples below:

Situation	Suggestion
Mary looks tired	Why <b>don't you</b> go to bed?
Alice looks sick	Why <b>don't you</b> go to the doctor?
Mark says he is hungry	Why <b>don't you</b> eat something?
Julia wants to see you	Why <b>don't we</b> meet at the restaurant?
