The past simple

- Use **the past simple** to talk about actions, events or states **finished** in the past.
 - Here are examples of some **irregular past simple verbs**.

verb past simple		
go	I went to the cinema with my friends.	
see	I saw a play at the theatre last week.	
do	I did a lot of exercise yesterday.	
have	I had a great vacation.

Remember to use the auxiliary verb **did** and the **infinitive** of the **main verb** to form questions using the past simple.


