

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■ We use **isn't** and **aren't** in **be -** questions.

- is not = isn't
- are not = aren't


Questions	Answers
Who <b>is</b> a doctor?	l am a doctor.
Who <b>isn't</b> a doctor?	You are not a doctor.
Who <b>is</b> a teacher?	You are a teacher.
Who <b>isn't</b> a teacher?	l am not a teacher.



■ We use **don't** and **doesn't** in **do-** questions.

- do not = don't
- does not = doesn't

Questions	Answers
When <b>do</b> you drive to work?	I drive to work when traffic is light.
When <b>don't</b> you drive to work?	l <b>don't</b> drive to work when traffic is heavy.
Where <b>does</b> Kim live?	Kim lives in Switzerland.
Where <b>doesn't</b> Kim live?	Kim <b>doesn't</b> live in Germany.




We can ask short questions.

We can give short answers.

Questions	Answers	Short answers
<b>Who</b> is a doctor?	<b>l am</b> a doctor.	l am.
<b>Who</b> isn't a doctor?	<b>She isn't</b> a doctor.	She isn't.
<b>What</b> do you drive?	l drive <b>a car</b> .	A car.
<b>What</b> don't you drive?	l don't drive <b>a taxi</b> .	A taxi.

■ We can also make suggestions using the **negative form** of **do**:

■ Why + do/does + not + subject

See the examples below:

Situation	Suggestion
Mary looks tired	Why <b>don't you</b> go to bed?
Alice looks sick	Why <b>don't you</b> go to the doctor?
Mark says he is hungry	Why <b>don't you</b> eat something?
Julia wants to see you	Why <b>don't we</b> meet at the restaurant?
