#### **Review the present continuous**

- Use the **present continuous** when talking about things you are doing right now
- Form the present continuous with **to be** and **verb + ing**

Personal Pronoun	Present continuous	
I	am eating.	
You	are eating a tomato.	
He, she, it	is buying oil and meat.	
We	are buying vegetables, not seafood.	



# **Speaking in the present continuous**



When we speak in the present continuous, we often combine the **personal pronoun** and the form of **to be**.

l am eating	<b>I'm</b> eating
You are eating —	You're eating
He is eating —	He's eating
We are eating	<b>We're</b> eating
They are eating	They're eating

#### Forming questions with the present continuous

To form a question in the present continuous, the **verb** comes first and the **subject pronoun** comes second.

Statement	Question
You are eating cookies.	Are you eating cookies?
She is drinking juice.	Is she drinking juice?
They are buying chips and milk.	Are they buying chips and milk?



#### Present simple vs. present continuous

The **present continuous** is used for things happening right now or are in progress. For things you normally do, use the **present simple.** Compare the examples below.

Present Simple	Present Continuous
I eat fruit every day.	I am eating a banana for lunch.
She buys food on Tuesdays.	She is buying food from the store now.
I drink lots of water.	I'm drinking lots of water.
You drink juice and milk.	You're drinking juice and milk today.
